During review, the submitted full papers or extended abstracts, if excellent, can be accepted by the program committee, as either an extended (8 pages) or a regular (5 pages) paper. Each submission will be reviewed by at least three members of the International Program Committee. Participants may also submit a 1 page abstract for a regular (5 pages) or short (3 pages) paper or a poster, which will be reviewed by only 1 member of the International Program Committee. Submissions, written in English, must clearly indicate the name, affiliation, address, phone number and email address of the primary authors. They must clearly state what is new and point out significant results. In case of multi-authors, one author should be identified as the corresponding author for the paper. Only original papers, which have not been published previously elsewhere will be accepted.
